C058 Magnolia officinalis var biloba 24.00

Large spreading deciduous tree with large leaves. Flowers are white and fragrant, flowering in November/December. Similar to M.obovata. 20m

C059 Magnolia sargentiana robusta 18.00

White flushed mauve pink, darker on the outside. Flowers are up to 25-30cm across and appear before the leaves. 10m

C060 Pseudolarix amabilis 12.00

Slow growing deciduous conifer grown for its outstanding golden orange autumn foliage, but the new soft green long spring leaves are very attractive also. 7m

C061 Pterostyrax corymbosa 12.00

Little epaulette tree. Deciduous tree with hanging panicles of white fragrant flowers in summer. 6m

C064 Rhopalostylis sapida 24.00

Nikau palm from Chatham Islands, Pitt Island in particular. The most southerly palm in the world, slow growing but the fastest of all the Nikaus, withstands wind and hardy to -5 degrees.

C065 Rosa rugosa 'Blanc double du Coubert' 12.00

Double white, fragrant tough hardy rugosa rose.

C066 Tecomanthe speciosa 18.00

Native vigorous climber from the Three Kings Islands. Frost tender when young, long tubular cream flowers April to July followed by long sausage like green pods.
